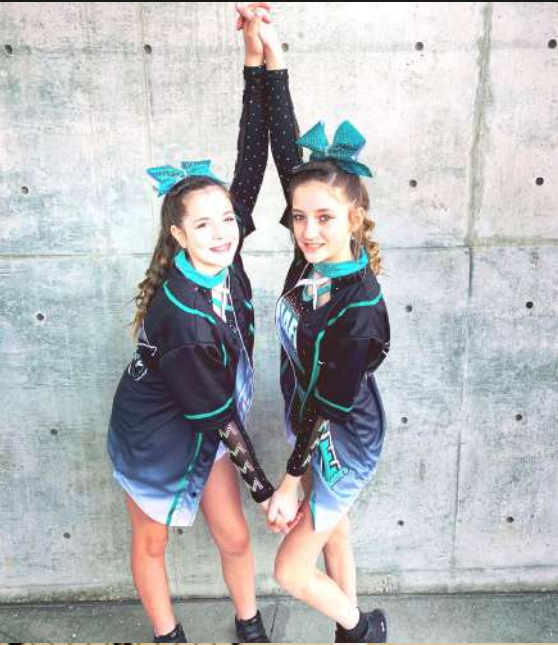

# EVALUATION INFORMATION



## HOW DO EVALUATIONS WORK?

All Elite athletes are invited to attend a clinic on Thursday May 5th and 6th  
ages 6-11 5-7pm Ages 12-18. 7-9pm

All Prep athletes are invited to attend a clinic on Thursday June 2nd and 3rd  
Ages 5-9 5-6:30 pm Ages. 10 and up 6:30-8pm

During their clinic they will get a chance to learn and review the evaluation material needed for tryouts.. Athletes will have the opportunity to get help as they get ready for their evaluation as our coaches will be on site.

Tryouts will be May 7th for Elite placement. Please wear black top, black shorts, hair in a pony and shoes are required. Ages 6-11. 11am-12:30pm

Ages 12-18 1-2:30pm

Tryouts will be June 4th for Prep/Novice placement. Please wear white top, black shorts, hair in a pony and shoes are required. Ages 5-9. 11am-12:30pm.

Ages. 10 and up 1-2:30pm . They will tryout in groups of 4.

## IMPORTANT EVALUATION DATES:

- Elite placement will be announced May 8th on our insta and Facebook page. Athletes who do not make an Elite team will automatically be placed on a prep team and do not need to try out again in June.
- Elite mandatory parent/athlete meeting is on May 12th at MVE @ 6pm
- Elite Season 5 begins the week of May 23rd , 2022
- Prep placement will be announced June 5th on our insta and Facebook page. Some prep athletes could potentially make an Elite Team and will join practices asap.
- Prep mandatory parent/athlete meeting is on June 9th at MVE @ 6pm
- Prep Season 5 begins the week of June 20th, 2022



# TEAM INFORMATION



## HOW DO YOU PLACE TEAMS?

There may be athletes on any given team that tumble at different levels than the rest of their team. We try to match up the athletes by level as best as we can, but please remember that stunting, pyramids, jumps, dance, and motions are a factor as well. Some athletes will be stronger tumblers than others, while some will contribute to stunting more than others. Creating a team is like a giant puzzle and we need to make sure we all fit together perfectly. Every athlete is placed on the team we think they will be the most successful on.

## PREP & ELITE SKILLS BY LEVEL:

The following are the skills that will be performed by level at tryouts.

### Level 1:

Standing Tumbling: Handstand Forward Roll  
Running Tumbling: Front and Back Walkover Series

### Level 2:

Standing Tumbling: Standing Back Handspring  
Running Tumbling: Round Off Back Handspring

### Level 3:

Standing Tumbling: Standing Series Handsprings  
Running Tumbling: Round Off BHS Tuck

### Level 4:

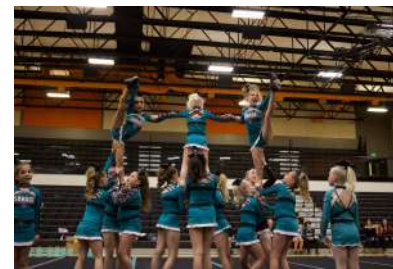
Standing Tumbling: Standing Tuck and 1 to Tuck  
Running Tumbling: Round Off BHS Layout

### Level 5:

Standing Tumbling: Series Handsprings to Layout  
Running Tumbling: Round Off BHS Full

### Level 6:

Standing Tumbling: Series to Full and Jump Tuck  
Running Tumbling: Specialty to full or Round off BHS Double Full



## AGE GROUPS:

Your eligibility age for the season is based off of the year your athlete was born. Many athletes will fall into more than one category. We will place them based on what we feel is the best fit for the athlete.

New Athletes- please bring a copy of your birth certificate for MVE to have on file.

2022-2023 Elite/Prep Age groups per USASF guidelines:

Tiny Teams- Born in 2015-2017

Mini Teams- Born in 2013-2016

Youth Teams- Born in 2010-2016

Junior Teams- Born in 2006-2015

Senior Teams- Born in 6/1/2003- 2010

## TUITION

Tuition is paid monthly per athlete for all teams.

- Tuition for all teams are automatically drafted the 1st of every month from beginning of the season until the last month of the season.

Tuition covers all team practices as well as practice wear, music, choreography, Usaf fees, and backpack. Discounts apply to the tuition only for multiple sibling discounts.

### Tuition for Novice Teams for the 2022-2023 Season is:

- \$143 per month for 7 months or \$1000 + uniform fee and comp fees paid separate.

### Tuition for Prep Teams for the 2022-2023 Season is:

- \$150 per month for 10 months = \$1500 + uniform fee and comp fees paid separate.

### Tuition for Elite Teams for the 2022-2023 Season is:

- \$164 per month for 11 months = \$1800 + uniform fee and comp fees paid separate.

ALL TRAVEL EXPENSES SUCH AS HOTEL, FUEL, SPECTATOR TICKETS, FOOD, FLIGHTS, RENTAL CARS, ARE AT THE COST OF THE FAMILIES AND ARE NOT INCLUDED IN ANY OF OUR PRICES.

## DISCOUNTS AND SAVINGS:

1. Loyalty discount of 1% per completed season. Discount on tuition only.
2. Pay in Full, (Cash only) discount of \$200 off tuition only
3. Sibling discount of 10% off tuition for second child, 15% off tuition for third child, 20% off tuition for fourth child. 5th child gets free tuition.



## UNIFORM AND COMP FEES:

Uniform fees listed on program comparison page are fees paid to outside vendors for such items. We offer a variety of ways for you to pay your uniform fees. You can select a pay in full option, 2 month option which will be added to your monthly tuition or 4 month option which will be added to your monthly tuition. Items not paid for will not be purchased and child will not be able to continue on team.

**We do not discount uniforms nor do we offer refunds. However we do offer a program called a buy back. You can sell your uniform to another athlete at your set price and then you purchase a new uniform with those funds.**

**Comp Fees will be charged out 1 month before the competition and must be paid immediately. These fees range from \$65 to \$150 depending on the competition. If competition fees are still outstanding 2 weeks prior to event the athlete will be removed from competition and adjustments to the routine will be made.**

## I COMPLETED TRYOUTS NOW WHAT?

- After tryouts, we will take the athletes scores and assign each athlete to a team that we fill is best. Teams will be announced the day after tryouts on our Instagram and Facebook page. Team placements can and will happen throughout the summer depending on many factors.

## WHEN WILL MY CHILD PRACTICE?

Each team will receive a practice schedule for the season. These can not be created until we see what teams we will have for the season.

## WHEN IS CHOREOGRAPHY CAMP

Choreography for Prep/Novice and Elite Teams:

Elite- First week of August

Prep/Novice- Second week of August

Choreography is mandatory for all team members. Absence means not added into routine and spot has been given up.

Each team has 2-3 days of choreography for 3-5 hours at a time.

## CAN I WATCH PRACTICE?

We prefer practices to be closed to viewing as kids typically do better when parents aren't watching.

However the last week of every month we will allow parents to come in the last hour of their practice time to observe.

As we get close to comp season we will ask parents to come support and watch practices as well.

## WHEN IS SKILLS CAMP?

Skills Camp: Fee paid separate

MVE Skills Camp will take place at MVE Vontae from Trinity Valley Community College will be coming to Idaho and will be teaching our camp. Camp is important as it is when we start solidifying stunt groups and roles. While camp is not required, missing camp is very difficult for athletes as they miss valuable instruction as well as team bonding experiences. Dates for this camp are TBD but know they will be in July.

*There are no refunds for missing camp, camp fees are calculated on a set number of athletes. Do your best to plan ahead!*





# TEAM/ATHLETE POLICIES



## ABSENCES

Attendance is crucial to the success of any team. An absence request form should be submitted prior to missing any practice.

### Excused Absences

- Contagious Illness
- Graded School Functions
- Family Emergency

### Unexcused Absences

- School Dances or Games
- Traffic
- Too much homework or studying for finals
- Feeling tired
- No ride

## WHERE CAN I FIND AN ABSENCE REQUEST?

All of our forms can be found on your Program BAND. When your child is assigned to a team they will receive directions for how to access this. This form should be completed at least two weeks prior to any absence. Each athlete receives 3 unexcused absences per season, if a 4th occurs athlete will be removed from the team.

ATHLETES CAN NOT MISS PRACTICES THE WEEK BEFORE A COMPETITION OTHERWISE THEY WILL BE REMOVED FOR THAT COMPETITION AND ROUTINE WILL BE ADJUSTED.



## VACATIONS

Please work to plan your family vacations around the gym schedule, we work hard to give you the gym closures early. If you are wanting to take a vacation for spring break note that we usually have competitions around that time so being gone may not be an option. Once the competition schedule is released, the week prior to a competition is blacked out, athletes who miss a practice during these weeks will not be eligible to compete at the competition that week.

## INJURIES

If an injury should occur, it is the responsibility of the parent to seek professional help. After seeing a physician, please provide us with an evaluation of the athletes injury and status. An athlete with a serious injury will not be allowed to return to activity without a release from a medical professional.

## TRAVEL/COMPETITIONS

During the competition season, cheerleaders will be asked to travel to events. Some athletes will travel to national events out of the state. In this case, a separate rule sheet maybe handed out closer to the time of the competition. Transportation to competitions is the responsibility of each team member and their family.



# TEAM/ATHLETE POLICIES



## UNIFORMS AND ATTIRE

Please keep all MVE Clothing and uniforms in good condition. Please report any lost or damaged uniform items to your coach. The cost of replacement will be the responsibility of the athlete.

Athletes can not have any piercings and/or jewelry in for competitions. Please be mindful of this when thinking of getting new piercings. Band-aids or clear space holders will not be allowed.

## COPYRIGHT NOTICE:

The logo of Magic Valley Elite belongs to the owner of the program. You cannot sell or create your own MVE clothing or any other items. This includes team names and any likeness to logo, affiliation and/or program without the permission of Sara Weber, Owner Of Magic Valley Elite. .



## DISCIPLINE

If any of the above rules are compromised, the following actions will occur:

- 1st violation- Meeting with the athlete to define the problem
- 2nd violation- Meeting with the athlete and parent
- 3rd violation- Athlete may be removed from the team or entire program

# PARENT POLICIES



## COMMUNICATION

To streamline communication, As a parent, you will receive information one way, we will use an app with team groups in which all events and current information can be found. We will give information after tryouts on how to join the app.

## GOSSIP AND VIEWING AREA

- Our viewing area is for your convenience to allow you to watch your child practice.
- Siblings are not to be left unattended in the facility nor are to be running around the facility.
- Our viewing area is supposed to be a positive environment. It is your job as a parent to love and support your child, leave the coaching to us.
- In the event of parents being an issue in the viewing area they will be asked to leave or could be removed permanently.
- Viewing areas have rules and expectations posted, please adhere to them.
- Videos and Photos of practice are allowed to be taken from the viewing area but not allowed to be posted on any social media.
- By registering to be a part of our program you understand and agree to this.

## FUNDRAISING

MVE offers the following:

- A new fundraiser every 6 weeks. These are individual fundraisers and all credits will go directly to your account. These fundraisers do involve extra work outside of cheer but we have seen people pay for an entire season of cheer! We strongly suggest you participate in fundraising.
- We will also have gym fundraisers to help cover the costs of those athletes sponsored.
- If athlete is sponsored fundraising credits will be applied back to MVE and not given back as credit to the family in monetary value.

## FEES

- A schedule of payments is listed in this handbook. All monthly payments are set up in Go Motion and come out automatically on the 1st of the month. If you choose to make a payment and not have your designated card charged, you must bring a check, cash or Venmo the payment to Sara before the 1st of the month. Please make all checks payable to Magic Valley Elite. Venmo address is @Sara-Weber-24
- A late fee of \$25 will be assessed for all payments made after the 5th of each month. If your payment is declined from your bank, please make the payment immediately with another form of payment.
- Monthly tuition is not pro-rated for any reason.
- Uniform and Comp fees are non-refundable. If you choose to leave or are removed from the team these fees are not returned.
- By the 5th of each month, your account must be up to date. Otherwise, your athlete will no longer be allowed to participate until acct is current.

# POLICY AGREEMENT



## Please Read, Initial and Sign Fees, Payments and Policies for Elite/Prep and Novice

\_\_\_1. The Cheer Season is a year commitment going from May to April for Elite. Prep is June to April and Novice is June to January. Be sure you can commit before signing for the season. MVE is to come before any and all other sports while in contract.

\_\_\_2. All MVE customers are required to have a card set up in Go Motion for all payments. All tuition is ran on the 1st of each month. Athletes will not be allowed to practice until there is a card on file.

\_\_\_3. Your account must be current for your child to participate in team practices, tumbling classes, open gyms, private lessons and or competitions.

\_\_\_4. All monthly fees, competition fees, and or uniform fees, must be paid in advance in order to participate in any event. **All fees are 100% Non-Refundable for any reason.**

\_\_\_5. If you chose to pay your fees in full and choose to discontinue anytime from May 2022 to April 2023, your fees are **Non-Refundable**. The inconvenience fee will still be charged the day of your dismissal. **NO REFUNDS** will be given. Remember you are signing up for a spot on an MVE team, not for a specific team or position.

\_\_\_6. I understand that if my child decides to quit the MVE program (for any reason other than family relocation with a valid real estate document, or a season ending sport injury with a valid physician's certificate) at any time from June 2022, to the end of the competition season April 2023, I will be charged a \$500 inconvenience fee, \$250 for Novice. This fee will be deducted from the card on file or needs to be paid by check within 5 days if card is not approved. If neither happen account will be sent to collections.

\_\_\_7. It is mandatory to abide by the Attendance policy as outlined in the 2022-2023 Athlete Policies given out in this packet. All athletes are to attend their teams regularly scheduled practices. If an athlete is not feeling well, or injured, they are still expected to be at practice. If your child has a fever or is vomiting they should not attend. A parent must fill out an absent form PRIOR to practice for this to be excused. All school activities and pre planned vacations should be submitted 14 days in advance as explained in the packet. After the athlete has reached 3 unexcused absences for the season if a 4th occurs the athlete will be removed from the program. If your athlete is constantly tardy, a meeting with the All Star director will take place along with the athlete and a parent. At this time your child may be removed from their team and program at the discretion of the All Star Director. Attendance is required for success.

\_\_\_8. If at any time your child misses a competition for an unexcused reason, this is means for immediate termination from the team and no refunds of any sort will be given.

\_\_\_9. MVE will issue a list of "Black Out Weeks", which are the week prior to a competition. During said black out weeks, any missed practices will result in the athlete not being able to compete at the next competition. No competition fee refunds will be given for missing a competition blackout practice.

\_\_\_10. Your child can and will be suspended from practices and or competitions for displaying inappropriate behavior and refusal to follow gym rules and instructions from coaches and staff. Please discuss this with your child. You are still responsible for your athlete's fees during the period of suspension.

\_\_\_11. Athletes should not be dropped off more than 15 minutes early for a team or class. Athletes should not be picked up more than 15 minutes from the end of their practice/class, as this requires coaches and staff to work past their set hours. After 15 minutes past a \$20 fee will charged to card on file.

# POLICY AGREEMENT



\_\_\_\_12 Fundraising- All fundraisers facilitated are individual, unless otherwise noted. We will apply credits to your accounts. Questions regarding fundraisers can be emailed to Mvecheer4life@icloud.com. Any surplus of credits from fundraisers can be used towards any services or products MVE offers. Funds can't be transferred to another athlete. If athletes leave with a credit that will be transferred to the general fund. Refund checks will not be issued in the result of a surplus.

\_\_\_\_13. All transportation to and from competitions is the sole responsibility of parents. I understand that some competitions require a specific hotel. Information will be given as those dates approach.

\_\_\_\_14. I understand that as a MVE member I am not allowed to use the Logo and make my own merchandise. I cannot sell or create your own apparel or merchandise. I also understand I am not allowed to contact any vendors on behalf of MVE. Doing so is grounds for dismissal from the program.

\_\_\_\_15. I understand that my athlete needs to come to practice every day in the proper attire. Athletes can wear anything for tumbling class but must be in the right attire for team practice. Hair needs to be up and secure.

\_\_\_\_16. We reserve the right to close practices at any time. This will occur if the viewing room becomes negative or distracting. Please remember to be your athlete's, team's and coach's biggest cheerleader! As a parent, if you are causing drama you can and will be removed from the gym.

This includes but is not limited to social media posts, photos, interactions and discussion boards. Any violation of this policy may result in immediate termination from the program.
